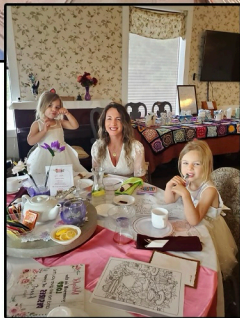

# Last Friday Monthly Turkey Feast



“Chef” Markus Staudinger and the rest of the kitchen staff pull out the stops and prepare a full turkey spread on the LAST Friday of every month, as part of the Chetco Activity Center’s Nutrition Program.

Every month approximately 50 plus people gather for a full on turkey feast followed by gourmet desserts, as prepared by Staudinger. On turkey feast Fridays, the Center cooks up 6 full size turkeys and 40 pounds of potatoes, plus other sides and desserts.

Meals are also served daily in the second floor dining area of the Activity Center. Average attendance is 25 to 30 on weekdays, while the turkey feast typically sees double that. Meals cost the Center about \$10 for each meal, which are served free of charge to those over age 60. Donations are requested but not required. For those under age 60, a \$10 charge applies.

Meals are also prepared and sent out to area homes as part of the Meals On Wheels program. An average of 60 meals are cooked, packaged, and delivered daily by several volunteer drivers.

Fundraising Event Coordinator and CAC Board Member Rita Howard has concerns about the future of the program as federal cuts are being made daily to programs that subsidize our local programs. “There’s some uncertainty,” she says. Donations are always welcome, Howard added.
